

Zimbabwe s first batch of power base stations

What is the largest power station in Zimbabwe?

Situated in the North Western part of Zimbabwe,Hwange Power Stationis the largest coal-fired power station with 920MW installed capacity which comprises of 4x120MW and 2x220 MW units. ... In 1955,it was decided to dam the Zambezi River at the Kariba Gorge to supply power to Zimbabwe and Zambia.

Who owns Zimbabwe Power Station?

It is owned and operated by the national electricity company Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority. It was built in two stages and consists of 4 units of 120 MW each,2 units of 220 MW each and 2 units of 300 MW each. Engineering Consultants,Merz &McLellan,were employed for the design and supervision of the construction of the power station.

What is the biggest power plant in Zimbabwe?

The Hwange Thermal Power Stationis the biggest power plant in Zimbabwe with an installed capacity of 1520 MW. It is owned and operated by the national electricity company Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority. It was built in two stages and consists of 4 units of 120 MW each,2 units of 220 MW each and 2 units of 300 MW each.

What are Zimbabwe's energy projects?

The Government of Zimbabwe has prioritised energy projects as one of the key enablers to economic growth and development. The prioritised projects include new plants and the optimization of existing plantsand are expected to add additional power to the grid as follows:

How much power does Zimbabwe import?

Currently power imports stand at around 400 MW. Industry and Commerce have struggled partly due to acute power shortages being experienced in the country. The Government of Zimbabwe has prioritised energy projects as one of the key enablers to economic growth and development.

How did ZPC finance Harare Power Station Repowering project?

Furthermore,the Bank also secured a mandate from ZPC to raise US\$11.2 million towards its 15% contribution of the EPC costs plus insurance cover for the Harare Power Station Repowering Project. The project is expected to be funded 85% with a concessional loanamounting to US\$70.2 million from India Exim Bank through the EPC contractor.
